Who We Are

Refugee Women of Bristol is a registered charity set up by a group of refugee women to advance education, relieve poverty, promote and protect the health of refugee women and those seeking asylum in Bristol and the surrounding area, through the provision of advice, information and support.

The management committee is entirely user-led and open to all women from a refugee background. We regularly have over 60 women accessing our weekly drop-in and over 500 women as members from over 40 different countries.

Our Services

Our drop-in is held every Tuesday during term time at Malcolm X Centre, St Pauls, Bristol. We welcome women from refugee and asylum seeking backgrounds, women on a spouse visa, and women who gained refugee status in another European country before coming to the UK.

We provide a number of activities including:

- English classes from pre-entry to entry level 3
- Information and advocacy
- A lunch club
- A free crèche
- Regular workshops
- Training opportunities
- FGM information sessions

We have Community Workers who are able to interpret in Somali, Arabic, and Chinese, and support women who may need letters translating, information about services, and support to contact agencies and organisations.
